My First Wrestling Tournament

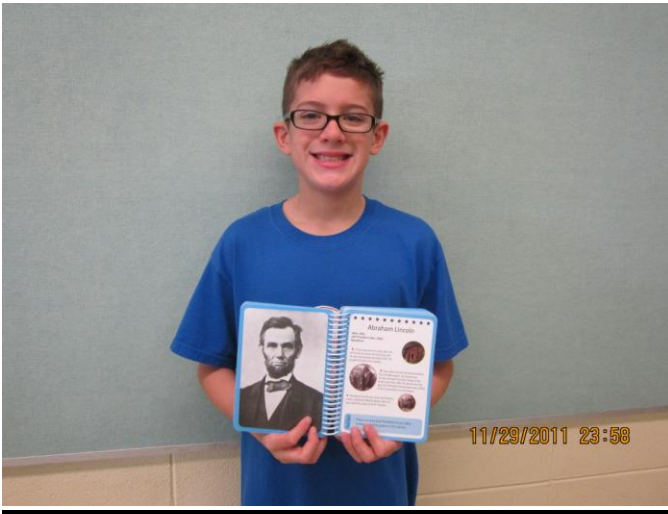
